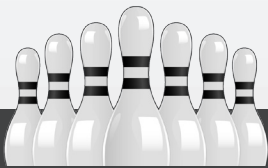

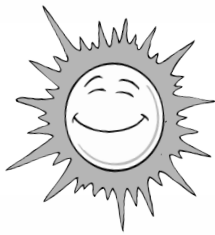

double dipping.

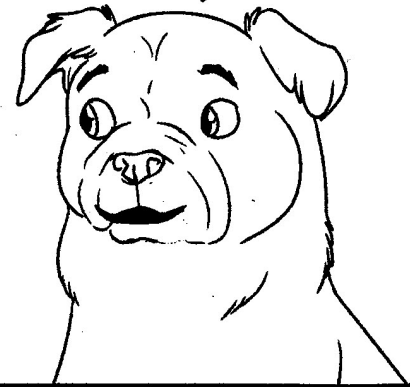
STewardShip JACK & Friends
